

AFL-CIO management wants the OPEIU Local 2 unit to accept:

Management Rights

Management maintains the right to impose up to 12 days of furloughs per year.

Under this language, management doesn't need to justify the furlough. There's no shared sacrifice or drop-dead date.

12 furlough days = a 4-5% wage cut per employee. This is in addition to a wage freeze for 3 more years.

Would you accept this language in your members' contracts?

Ask President Trumka and Secretary-Treasurer Shuler: Isn't this what unions fight against?
