**Nation Safe Drivers Towing/Service Calls** – Up to two towing/service calls per year for each member (includes family members living in the same household as the member) valued at up to \$100 USD each (\$80 USD call plus \$20 USD administrative fee) administered through Nation Safe Drivers;

**\$2,000 Death Benefit & \$2,000 Accidental Death and Dismemberment Benefit** – Certificates can be found on the website and app and can be printed and kept with your other important documents;

**OPEIU Free College Benefit** – Just as the name implies, OPEIU members and their families can earn an associate degree or certificates *completely free of charge*. Learn more at [FreeCollege.OPEIU.org](http://FreeCollege.OPEIU.org).

**OPEIU Bachelor's Completion Program** – OPEIU members and their families can earn a bachelor's degree for no more than \$4,500 out-of-pocket per year for a full-time student.
